


Peter Davies is a modern day Peter Pan – a serious film actor and nomadic adventurer facing an existential crisis as he reaches 40.

Torn between his carefree lifestyle and the societal and social pressures from family and friends to grow up and settle down, will he seek a higher purpose and leave Neverland?





The envy of his peers, Peter's external life appears ideal yet internally he struggles with alcohol addiction, questions his self-worth, and fears genuine intimacy.

PRIMARY CHARACTERS

PETER DAVIES

(Peter Pan)

Peter Davies (38) is a Canadian actor living in the U.S. He is a drifter bouncing from one location to the next. A recovering alcoholic, he is desperate to overcome his shadows and find deeper connection and meaning.

WENDY DARLING

Wendy (40) is a kindergarten teacher, writer, and single mother (Michael Darling) who has finally found her place in the world. When Peter enters her life again, she begins to question her fate.

MORALES HOOK

(Captain Hook)

Morales (late 60s) is a Native
American desert drifter living in a
van. Peter meets him while
hallucinating on peyote at a
desert party. Morales helps Peter
face his shadows.

MARIANNE SOUTHERLAND

(Tinkerbell)

Marianne (50) is the owner of The Bent Mast, a local dive bar in San Diego. She met Peter when he was in his mid-20s at which time they had a brief affair. Peter visits her when he needs advice. Marianne is his first love.

THE LOST BOYS

DEVIN MONTAGUE

Devin (35) is a club promoter, psychedelics aficionado, and trust fund baby who convinces Peter to go on strange adventures that challenge his perceptions of himself and the world.

ANDREW "INDY ANDY" SLIGHTLY

Andrew (37) is a motor-cross racer and stuntman who is often seen on extreme sports adventures with Peter. He has a penchant for anything fast and a weakness for destructive habits including unhealthy intimate relationships and associating himself with nefarious characters.

PHILIP "PIP" FROST

Pip (46) is an Australian actor and one of Peter's closest friends. Like Peter, he lives a life of adventure.

After two failed and childless marriages, Pip has resigned himself to life as a playboy, but underneath he is lonely and unhappy.

THE DAVIES FAMILY

ANN "ANNIE" ADAMS

Annie (35) is Peter's younger sister. She is married to accountant Max Adams and mother to twin boys, Lincoln and Duke. She provides a home for Peter to rest and regroup. Annie and Peter are close confidants.

SARAH DAVIES

Sarah (mid-60s) is a Canadian artist and Peter's doting mother.
She admires Peter, but her protective parenting encourages his childish behavior.

BRYAN DAVIES

Brian (late 60s) is an eccentric retired Canadian investment banker and Peter's father. Peter has a complicated relationship with Bryan, who is disappointed in his son's choice to become an actor instead of taking over the family business, now run by Peter's childhood friend, John Chang.

THE ADAMS FAMILY

MAX ADAMS

Max (42) is Ann's husband and father to their twins. He is a pragmatic individual who values a predictable schedule and the suburban lifestyle he lives.

LINCOLN ADAMS

Lincoln (6) is a precocious and daring child who is not afraid to take risks and loves exploring the outdoors. He represents the daring and risk-taking aspect of Peter's personality.

DUKE ADAMS

Duke (6) is a nerdy bookworm who is fascinated by scientific and historical facts. He believes everything follows a set of rules and that everyone should follow suit and think like he does. He challenges Peter's perceptions, but also represents the stubborn and self-righteous side of Peter's personality.

SEASON REGULARS

MICHAEL DARLING

Michael (24) is Wendy's conservative gay son.
Michael is a sharp and witty old soul who thinks he knows best. He helps
Wendy navigate her life and is protective of her.
Micheal runs a successful gaming company in Seattle with his boyfriend Sanjay.

TATE TELLASON

Tate (45) is an indie
filmmaker, clothing
designer, motorcycle
enthusiast, and one of
Peter's closest friends. Peter
is envious of Tate's lifestyle
and marriage. Tate is wise
and well-read. He offers
Peter advice in an indirect
and objective manner due
to his concerns about
judging Peter's choices.

JOHN CHANG

John (39) is Peter's childhood friend and runs Bryan Davies' investment firm. Peter and John are like day and night. Peter resents his father for choosing John to run his firm despite Peter's lack of interest and education. He projects his issues with his father onto John.

MARK RAMPLING

Mark (late-40s) is Peter's agent. He is a flamboyant opportunist who talks fast and means business. He introduces Peter to a variety of characters who challenge Peter's perceptions and career path as an actor.

SANJAY KARDEEP

Sanjay (26) is Michael's business partner and live-in boyfriend. He struggles with his identity and faces challenges with his conservative and traditional Indian family.


